

RAF Kenley Air Day 2010

**Commemorating the 70th Anniversary
of the Battle of Britain**

1. Permission has been obtained from the Ministry of Defence (RAF) to hold an air show at Kenley Airfield on Saturday 14th August 2010.
2. The event commemorates the 70th anniversary of the Battle of Britain during which Kenley played a significant role.
3. The air show is also timed to coincide with two other significant events; the bombing of Croydon on 15th August 1940 and the bombing of RAF Kenley on the 18th a date recorded in history as 'The Hardest Day'.
4. The event is planned as a community event. As with earlier events admission and parking on the airfield will be free of charge. A full colour souvenir brochure will be available for a small charge.
5. The maintenance fund of the RAF Kenley Tribute will be the sole beneficiary of any surplus made on the day.
